

Examiners' sheet 1**Candidate A****Task 1 Talk*****1a) 45-60 seconds per Candidate***

The Candidate is asked to talk for about 45-60 seconds on:

“Shopping”

1b) Two minutes per Candidate

After the talk, the Examiner asks the follow-up questions:

- Do you go to large shopping centres?
- Do you go shopping in town or outside of town?
- Who goes shopping with you?

The Examiner can, if necessary, use standard prompts such as:

Why is that? Why do you think that?

Can you give any examples?

Any other reasons/comments?

Examiners' sheet 2**Candidate B****Task 1 Talk****1a) 45-60 seconds per Candidate**

The Candidate is asked to talk for about 45-60 seconds on:

“Free-time activities”

1b) Two minutes per Candidate

After the talk, the Examiner asks the follow-up questions:

- Do you have much time for hobbies?
- What kind of hobby would you like to have?
- What sort of hobbies do your friends have?

The Examiner can, if necessary, use standard prompts such as:

Why is that? Why do you think that?

Can you give any examples?

Any other reasons/comments?

Candidate A

Before the test starts, the Candidate has ten minutes in the preparation room to prepare herself/himself to talk about the picture. He/She may make notes, but not complete sentences.

Task 2 Presentations and discussion
